This year's lawn bowling trip featured 12 days in the Great Northwest. The trip started in Seattle where we enjoyed evening bowls at the Jefferson Park LBC (host of the 2011 U.S. Championships). While in Seattle we toured the Boeing aircraft assembly plant which was well worth the visit.

Next we traveled by Clipper Ferry to Victoria, Canada.

Our two day stay in Victoria included an afternoon of lawn bowling at the Oak Bay LBC, multiple sightseeing opportunities including:

the Fairmont Empress Hotel, Parliament buildings and the beautiful downtown area. Then it was off to the famous Butchart's Gardens which were better than advertised.

This visit was followed by a trip to Vancouver aboard the BC Passenger Ferry. On our first day in Vancouver we bowled at the Stanley Park (Vancouver) LBC which had great greens in an absolutely perfect harbor setting. The next day we took a trolley tour of the city which started at Stanley Park and included a short excursion by water taxi to Granville Island for shopping and lunch.

The next morning we boarded the famous Rocky Mountaineer Train for a two day trip through absolutely awesome Rocky Mountains with rivers, lakes and of course a lot of greenery. The train stopped overnight in the town of Kamloops where we were treated to a banquet dinner and live musical revue. The last leg of the train journey was a full day's ride to Banff. From there we bussed to Lake Louise for an overnight stay at the Deer Lodge. A tour of the nearby Lake Louise Fairmont Hotel was magnificent but was outdone by the spectacular view of the lake. Later that day, we took a motor coach trip back to Banff to take the Ariel Tram to the areas highest peak. Atop the mountain we were served an excellent lunch while enjoying the spectacular views of the entire Banff Springs area.

Next up was a motor coach trip to Calgary where we were hosted to a delicious lunch and an afternoon of bowling at the Stanley Park (Calgary) LBC followed by a tour of the city. Finally we ended the trip with an excellent dinner atop the Calgary Tower surrounded by sundown views of the city.
