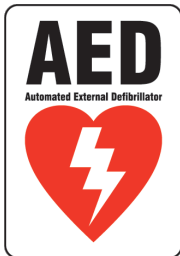

AED Training at NHLBC
Sat, May 20th at 12 noon

On Saturday, May 20th, we will hold Automated External Defibrillation (AED) training immediately following social bowls. If you can't attend the 10:00 draw, plan to be at the club at noon. This training will merely take 20 to 30 minutes, and just might save someone's life. The AED equipment is prominently displayed on the west side of the clubhouse door, but without training you might not be able to use it in an emergency. Of course, our fondest wish is that no one ever has a need to use the equipment. But if one of our club members has a heart attack, immediate action makes the difference between life and death. Please prioritize this lifesaving training and join us.

The members who were trained last year need to renew their certification. So, even though you might think, "I already did that!" it's time for a refresher.
